Introduction

Pennsylvania has not enacted regulations that specifically address the management of used or discarded electronic equipment, beyond the adoption of the state's universal waste rule. However, Pennsylvania is a member of the Mid-Atlantic Consortium of Recycling and Economic Development Officials ("MACREDO"). In addition, Pennsylvania participated in EPA's Region 3 eCycling 14-month pilot program in 2001- 2002 to demonstrate the feasibility of a multi-State electronics collection, reuse, and recycling program that shared responsibility among government, industry, and consumers.
